DSCSA Basics

- **Drug Supply Chain Security Act of 2013 (DSCSA)**, 21 U.S.C. 360eee, *et seq.*
 - A 50-state state-by-state system risked leaving weak links, conflicting rules, or unnecessary burdens when the system relies on one or more state requirements.
- Supply Chain = Downstream Distribution Chain

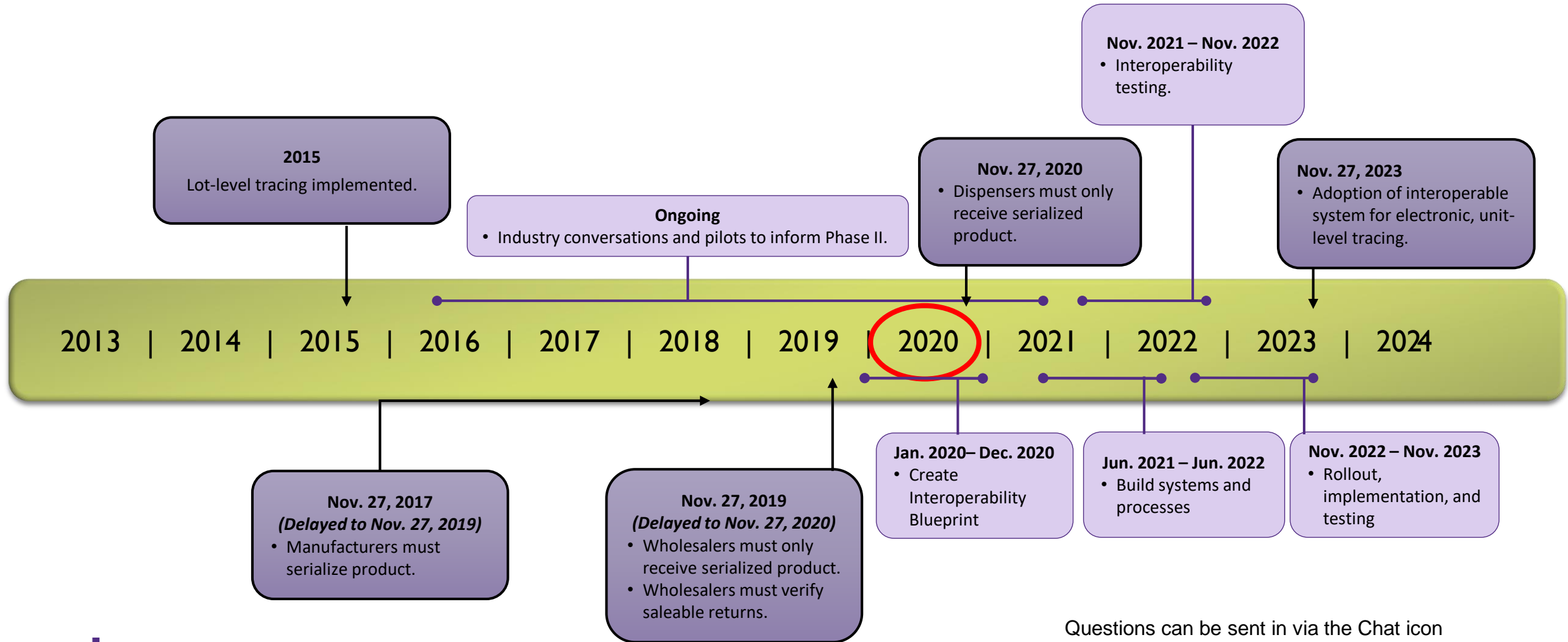

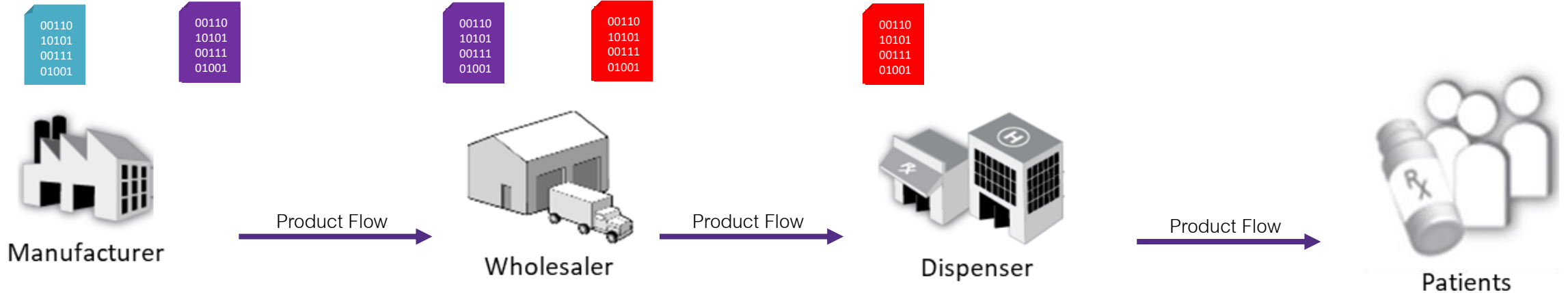
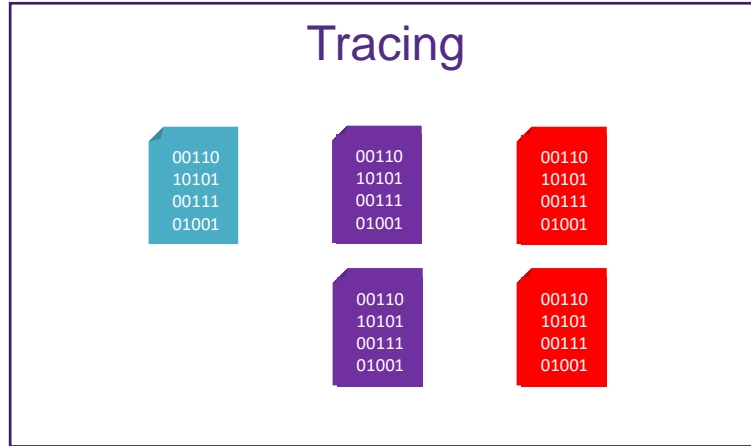
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DSCSA Basics: Timeline



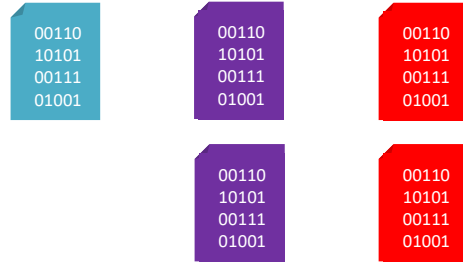
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DSCSA Basics: Tracing

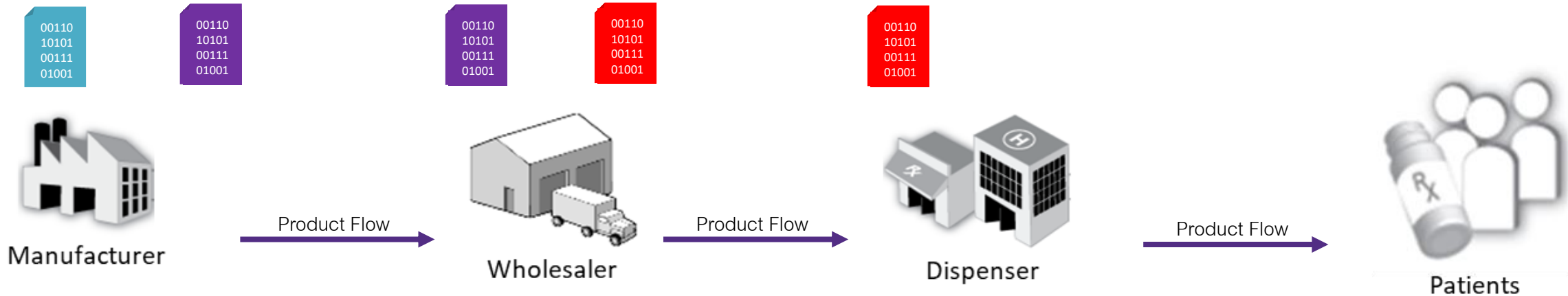


DSCSA Basics: Tracing

Minimum = 5 Data Records



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DSCSA Basics: Tracing

5 records per Product Identifier X 4.5 billion units distributed per year =

22.5 billion records per year

22.5 billion records per year X 6 year data retention requirement =

135 billion records in the supply chain

135 billion records in the supply chain distributed across tens of thousands of trading partners

Tracing = How do you promptly identify the 5 relevant records from the haystack of 135 billion records across tens of thousands of trading partners?

PDG: Governance Function

- **Need:** DSCSA interoperability will require a level of cooperation, coordination, and interconnection at the unit level not present today. Efficient implementation requires an intentional implementation plan.
- **Purpose:** Develop a vision for full implementation of DSCSA interoperability and advance commitment to that vision.
- **Scope:** Interoperable verification and tracing (as required by DSCSA), including practices and processes that impact the integrity and reliability of interoperable verification and tracing.
