

Stephan's career in pharmaceuticals and biologicals spans 25+ years and since 2021, he is the Global Quality Lead for Supply Chain Projects at Lonza.

He holds a Master in Chemistry from the University of Leuven (Belgium) and started his career in pharma business at Janssen Pharmaceutica (J&J), where he held various QA positions in different domains with increasing responsibilities. His first position related to suppliers was at Janssen Pharmaceutica, where he started as an auditor. He then took more and more responsibilities, and became the Head of the Global Supplier Quality organization for small and large molecules. In between he was the Director External Supply operations managing the operational activities for all contract manufactures for the global vaccines network at GSK.

During Stephan's career, he created several global organizations, developed, optimized and implemented several key corporate processes and managed international and virtual teams.

He emphasizes on meeting expectations for both suppliers and customers, by giving visibility throughout the whole supply chains, collaboration, and continuous improvement.
