Rx-360 is committed to protecting the privacy, confidentiality, and integrity of information provided through the Supplier Assessment Questionnaire (SAQ) tool.

Purpose of the SAQ Tool

The SAQ is a standardized assessment tool made available by Rx-360 to facilitate the exchange of quality and compliance information between manufacturers and suppliers. The tool is designed solely to support assessment standardization and industry collaboration.

Information We Collect

- When using the SAQ tool, manufacturers and suppliers provide basic contact details.
 Rx-360 uses this information only to operate the tool, engage with members, and share updates consistent with our mission.
- SAQ responses themselves remain under supplier control and are shared only with the manufacturers designated by the supplier. Rx-360 does not host or retain completed responses.

Data Ownership & Control

- Suppliers own their SAQ responses.
- Manufacturers receive responses only when suppliers choose to share them.
- Rx-360 does not publish, disclose, or distribute responses, and does not permanently host or archive completed assessments.

Confidentiality & Security

- Supplier responses are shared only with the manufacturer(s) designated by the supplier.
- Rx-360 implements reasonable safeguards, including secure connections (SSL/TLS) and controlled access measures to protect contact information collected.
- Supporting documents and responses remain within the control of the supplier and intended recipient(s).

Compliance with Applicable Laws

 Rx-360 complies with applicable privacy and data protection laws, including global frameworks such as the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). Personal information will only be collected and processed with your consent, and only for the purposes described above.

Retention & Deletion

- Rx-360 retains manufacturer and supplier contact information only for as long as necessary to fulfill engagement and marketing purposes.
- SAQ responses are not stored or hosted by Rx-360.
- Individuals may request correction or deletion of their contact information at any time by contacting Rx-360 directly.

Consent to Use

By using the SAQ tool, manufacturers and suppliers acknowledge and agree that Rx-360 may collect and use contact information as described in this policy. Use of the SAQ tool is conditioned upon this consent.

Incident Response & Breach Notification

- 1. Incident Discovery and Investigation
 - Rapid identification occurs from remote monitoring capabilities.
 - Investigation involves root cause analysis, impact assessment, and containment measures to prevent further damage.
- 2. Incident Management Framework
 - Immediate containment of the breach
 - Notification of internal stakeholders and relevant external parties
 - Documentation of the incident, actions taken, and outcomes
 - Corrective and preventive actions (CAPA) to avoid recurrence
 - Engagement with law enforcement or regulatory bodies if necessary
- 3. Notification of Affected Parties
 - Rx-360 emphasizes transparency and timely communication
 - Affected parties, including consortium members and potentially impacted suppliers or customers, should be notified promptly
 - Notifications include:
 - Nature and scope of the breach
 - Data potentially compromised
 - Steps taken to mitigate the issue
 - Guidance for affected parties (e.g., password changes, monitoring for suspicious activity)

4. Post-Incident Review

- o Rx-360 encourages a "lessons-learned" approach to improve future incident response.
- This includes updating policies, training, and technical safeguards based on the incident analysis.

• Data Transfer & Cross-Border Issues

1. Alignment with Global Data Protection Laws

- Rx-360 operates internationally and collaborates with pharmaceutical and medical device companies across jurisdictions. Therefore, it likely adheres to major data protection frameworks such as:
 - GDPR (EU)
 - UK GDPR & IDTA
 - U.S. Privacy Laws (including Executive Order 14117)
 - China's PIPL
 - India's DPDPA [www.b2becosystem.com]
- These laws require that personal and sensitive data transferred across borders be protected with equivalent safeguards as in the originating jurisdiction.

Ongoing Monitoring & Review

- Annual reviews are scheduled, with interim updates as needed.
 - Stakeholders are consulted on change implementation as needed.
 - Version control is utilized and change logs are kept.
 - Impact assessments are conducted for new data uses or transfers.
 - Training and awareness is provided for staff and consortium members.
